OPEN ENROLLMENT : NOVEMBER 1-15

If you want or need insurance for 2024,
you **MUST** enroll by November 15.

This enrollment period includes elections for:

- dental insurance
- health insurance
- short-term disability
- supplemental insurance (accident, critical illness, and hospital indemnity)
- vision insurance

IMPORTANT

Employees that are choosing to have their kids or spouse on the plan must submit supporting evidence (i.e. proof they are your child, etc.)

The plans offered are NOT with CareFirst but are still BC/BS. Confirm with your doctors to ensure that they participate with the plan you are enrolling in.
