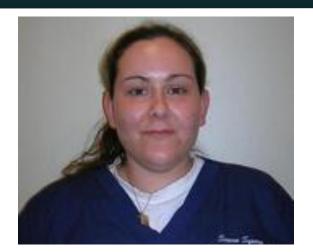




Client Service Representatives (CSR)

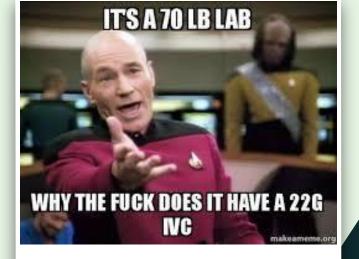






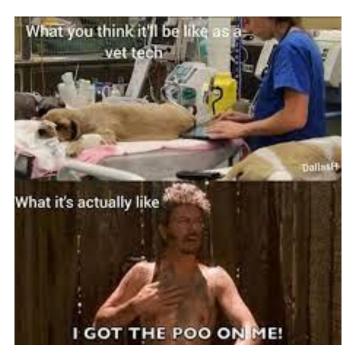
- Owner communication

- Communicate with Shift Leads and doctors regarding incoming patients
- Technician responsibilities
 - Take radiographs
 - Draw blood
 - Obtain BPs
 - Assist in DVM exams

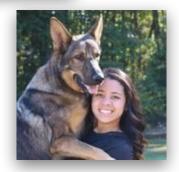
